Matthew 4:1-11 (NLT)

The Temptation of Jesus

- ¹ Then Jesus was led by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted there by the devil. ² For forty days and forty nights he fasted and became very hungry.
- ³ During that time the devil^[a] came and said to him, "If you are the Son of God, tell these stones to become loaves of bread."
- ⁴ But Jesus told him, "No! The Scriptures say,
 - 'People do not live by bread alone,
 - but by every word that comes from the mouth of God.'(Deut 8:3)"
- ⁵ Then the devil took him to the holy city, Jerusalem, to the highest point of the Temple, ⁶ and said, "If you are the Son of God, jump off! For the Scriptures say,
 - 'He will order his angels to protect you.

And they will hold you up with their hands

- so you won't even hurt your foot on a stone.'(Psalms 91:11-12)"
- ⁷ Jesus responded, "The Scriptures also say, 'You must not test the LORD your God.' (Deut 6:16)"
- ⁸ Next the devil took him to the peak of a very high mountain and showed him all the kingdoms of the world and their glory. ⁹ "I will give it all to you," he said, "if you will kneel down and worship me."
- ¹⁰ "Get out of here, Satan," Jesus told him. "For the Scriptures say,
 - 'You must worship the LORD your God and serve only him.' (Deut 6:13)"
- ¹¹ Then the devil went away, and angels came and took care of Jesus.
 - 1. How did the devil attack Jesus?
 - 2. How did Jesus respond to each attack?
 - 3. How should we expect the devil to attack us?
 - 4. What can we do to defensively prepare?
